After entering the tournament, it is the responsibility of the player and the Member's National Association to secure the visa – if required. Please make any visa application as early as possible. A Physiotherapist will be available at the Sir Craig Reedie Centre. The fees for this service will be published closer to the event.				
Badminton Integrity Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament. To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match. Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches. Conditions of play

- 1. No player shall be eligible to compete unless he or she is a player in good standing with his or her national association. To "be in good standing" includes being a member of *BADMINTONscotland*
- 2. All matches shall be the best of three games to 21. An interval not exceeding sixty seconds shall be permitted when a player/pair reaches eleven points in any game. An interval not exceeding two minutes shall be allowed between games.
- 3. The period for knocking up before any match shall not exceed three minutes.
- 4. The Committee may restrict entries into all events.
- 5. Entry Forms: If players are unable to enter online, Entries must be sent to *BADMINTONscotland*, 40 Bogmoor Place, Glasgow G51 4TQ, accompanied by the appropriate remittance for entry fees, **NOT LATER THAN, WEDNESDAY 20 DECEMBER 2023**.
- 6. Late entries and entries sent without the appropriate entry fees will not be accepted.
- 7. No pair shall be accepted for a doubles event unless entry forms have been received from both players.
- 8. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry without giving their reasons.
- The Committee reserves the right to play any or all events in pool or round robin formats and to add to or alter these Conditions and its decisions are final.
- 10. Late entries and entries sent without the appropriate entry fees are unlikely to be accepted. Late entries may only be accepted at the discretion of the tournament director. A financial penalty is imposed by *BADMINTONscotland* of £5 per event for late entries to these Championships.
- 11. Regarding unannounced withdrawals from tournaments, a warning letter will be sent on the first offence and on a subsequent offence the matter will be referred to the Disciplinary Committee.

Anti-Doping

Badminton Scotland is opposed to the use of drugs in sport and is a member of and subject to the anti-doping jurisdiction of the BWF and UKAD. The tournament will be conducted with accordance to the tournament regulation of Badminton Scotland, including the anti-doping rules and tests may be carried out. The anti-doping rules of Badminton Scotland are binding on all athletes, Athlete Support Personnel and other persons participating in this event/tournament. Remember that many common asthma medications, and medications used for other common medical conditions require the player to apply for a Therapeutic Exemption Certificate from UK Sport.

We have recently created our own Scotland-specific Tournament Software site:

The first time you log into TS, you may need to reset/request a new password, this is because duplicate profiles have been merged. We don't anticipate any issues navigating TS, however if you run into any problems please email businessinfo@badmintonscotland.org.uk

How you access the new Tournament Software site to make your entry will depend on whether you already have a Tournament Software account, as well as whether you already have an account on JustGo. Please see below for guides on what to do for the various situations we anticipate members being in.

It is important to note that although your membership and tournament information are integrated, you still require a separate log in for both systems.

I already have both a TS and JG account

If you already have an account on TS, your existing login and password will still work and you shouldn't have any issues accessing the system. If you are an active member, your personal information will have been synchronised between the systems. Your JG account needs an active membership to feed your information through to TS and also to enter tournaments on TS. If you have forgotten your username or password, there are 'Forgot Username' and 'Forgot Password' options you can click to gain access.

If you can't remember if you have a TS and/or JG account, please email businessinfo@badmintonscotland.org.uk before creating a new profile.

I have a TS account but not a JG account

An active membership is needed to enter all TS tournaments online, you will need to register and become a member of Badminton Scotland. To do this, please see the instructions listed below under 'I don't have a TS or JG account'. Once you have done this, please email businessinfo@badmintonscotland.org.uk and ask us to link your accounts. Please note, we offer a trial membership which allows you to become a member free of charge. This will be useful for players visiting from overseas as the trial membership will allow you to enter 1 competition.

I don't have a TS account but I do have a JG account

Before being able to access TS, you will need to verify your details. To do this, please click here. You will need to enter your Member ID (ME followed by 6 digits), date of birth and competing gender, as is listed on your JG profile. You will need to have an active membership on JG in order to enter tournaments online. For instructions on how to become an active member, please see below.

I don't have a TS or JG account

First create an account on our membership system JG, then verify your details on TS. Everyone should have an active membership on JG before accessing TS for the first time. Please check with your club secretary that you don't already have an active membership. For instructions on how to register on JG, become an active member and access TS, see below:

- 1. Access the login page of JustGo.
- 2. Click to sign-up, enter your information and click register. Please keep a note of your login information.
- 3. Your profile will load. Select the 'Member Details' tab near the top of the page.
- 4. Under the 'Additional details' section, select your 'Group' and 'Playing Nationality' from the options provided. Do not worry about the greyed-out box titled 'Tournament ID', this will be completed for you.
- 5. Scroll to the top of the page and select the 'Membership' tab, next to the 'Member Details' tab.
- 6. Select a membership category. For most, this will be 'Individual Member'.
- 7. Choose a membership option (Annual, Trial, etc).
- 8. Proceed to the checkout when you are ready and complete.
- 9. Your information will now feed through to Tournament Software. To access the site, please click here.
- 10. Enter your Member ID, Birthdate and Competing Gender. Your member ID will begin with 'ME' followed by six numbers and can be found on your JustGo profile.

How do I enter a tournament?

To enter a tournament online, follow the instructions below:

- 1. Login to Tournament Software.
- 2. On the side menu, click 'Tournaments'.
- 3. Enter the name of the tournament you wish to enter in the search bar.
- 4. From the results, find the tournament and click online entry

How do I update my personal information on my TS account?

If you need to update your personal information on TS, please log on to your JG account and make the necessary changes. Note that you need to be an active member in order for any changes to go through.

How do I check I have an active membership?

Login to JustGo and access your profile. Beneath your display picture and name there should be the name and expiry date of your current membership. If this is empty, it means you don't have an active membership. See instructions for getting membership above.

Alternatively, you can also go to the 'Membership' tab to see your active membership/s. You can click on the membership category (e.g. Individual Member) for further information on active as well as expired memberships.

If your club normally handles your membership, check with your club secretary.

Please note, all Junior Regional Performance Squad players have active memberships.
